FREE LIBRARY SERVICE FOR HOMEBOUND CLIENTS

Residents of Payson and the surrounding areas are eligible for this service.

If you are interested, or if you know someone who would benefit from this service, please fill out the attached application and either mail it or bring it to the Payson Public Library.

To participate in the program, a Payson Public Library card is required. A volunteer can contact you if assistance is needed with completing an application for the library card.

Once enrolled, you'll be asked a few questions about your reading preferences, and any special services you may need to enhance your reading experience. A delivery day and time will also be established at this time that is convenient for both you and the volunteer. A volunteer will deliver books to your home on a regular basis according to your needs. Books are checked out for 3 weeks and are renewable as necessary. Movies may also be checked out.

You may modify your reading preferences or change the delivery day and time as needed. You may also discontinue the service at any time.
