October was another good month! The Bookstore's monthly sales total was \$1239.97, \$134 better than last October. The sales year-to-date total is \$10941.27, \$266 better than the same period last year. The Internet Sales group profit was \$294, \$39 better than last October. The *Last Whole Earth Catalog* sold for \$40. The combined group's year-to-date total is \$15,781.27, slightly better than last year—all due to a lot of hard work!
